Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall deductible ?	\$2,000/individual or \$4,000/family.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan , each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ?	Yes. Preventive care services and tier 1 drugs are covered before you meet your deductible .	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible . See a list of covered preventive services at https://www.healthcare.gov/coverage/preventive-care-benefits/ .
Are there other deductibles for specific services?	Yes. Prescription drugs – \$200 individual / \$400 family – applies to Tiers 2 through 4 drugs. There are no other specific deductibles .	You must pay all of the costs for these services up to the specific deductible amount before this plan begins to pay for these services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan ?	For participating providers \$6,750 individual / \$13,500 family.	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan , they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit ?	Copayments for certain services, premiums , balance-billing charges, optional addenda, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit .
Will you pay less if you use a network provider ?	Yes. See www.welcometouhc.com/uhcwest or call 1-800-624-8822 for a list of participating providers .	This plan uses a provider network . You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network . You will pay the most if you use a non-participating provider , and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your plan pays (balance billing). Be aware, your participating provider might use a non-participating provider for some services (such as lab work). Check with your provider before you get services.
Do you need a referral to see a specialist ?	Yes, written or oral approval is required, based upon medical policies.	This plan will pay some or all of the costs to see a specialist for covered services but only if you have a referral before you see the specialist .
